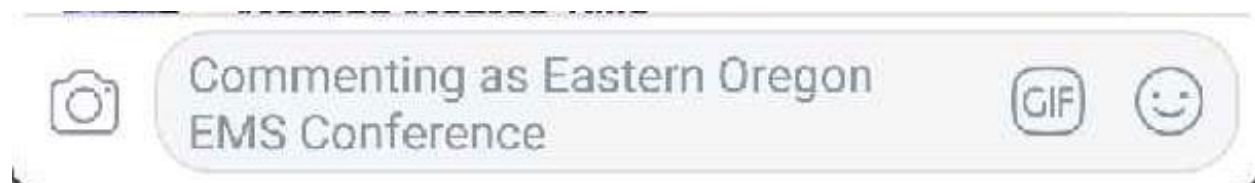

Innovative Mixed Simulation Emergency Services Training Symposium

Professor Brion Benninger MD MSc, was the guest speaker and coordinator of an all-day mixed simulation training session at the Eastern Oregon Emergency Medical Services annual conference in Pendleton Oregon Feb 15-18th, 2018. Dr. Benninger designed and taught a one-day mixed simulation training symposium which included his signature andragogical learning strategies incorporating cognitive load theory, color psychology, high-fidelity prototypes and special prepared donor cadaver towards eFAST ultrasound training techniques and mediums using classic and innovative probes. He also taught his developed technique for Interosseous IV (IO), as well as field video assisted intubation, cricothyrotomies, IV cut downs, ultrasound fracture triage and chest drains. Dr. Benninger is a strong supporter and teacher for prehospital healthcare specialists and military medicine. I was honored to design and present an innovative mixed simulation Emergency Services skills symposium to all the pre-hospital care specialists who traveled impressive distances to attend the symposium.
